- Best environmental practice

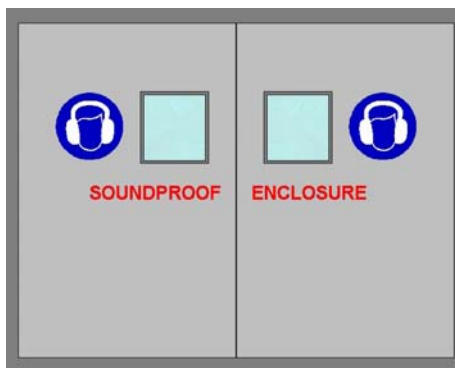
