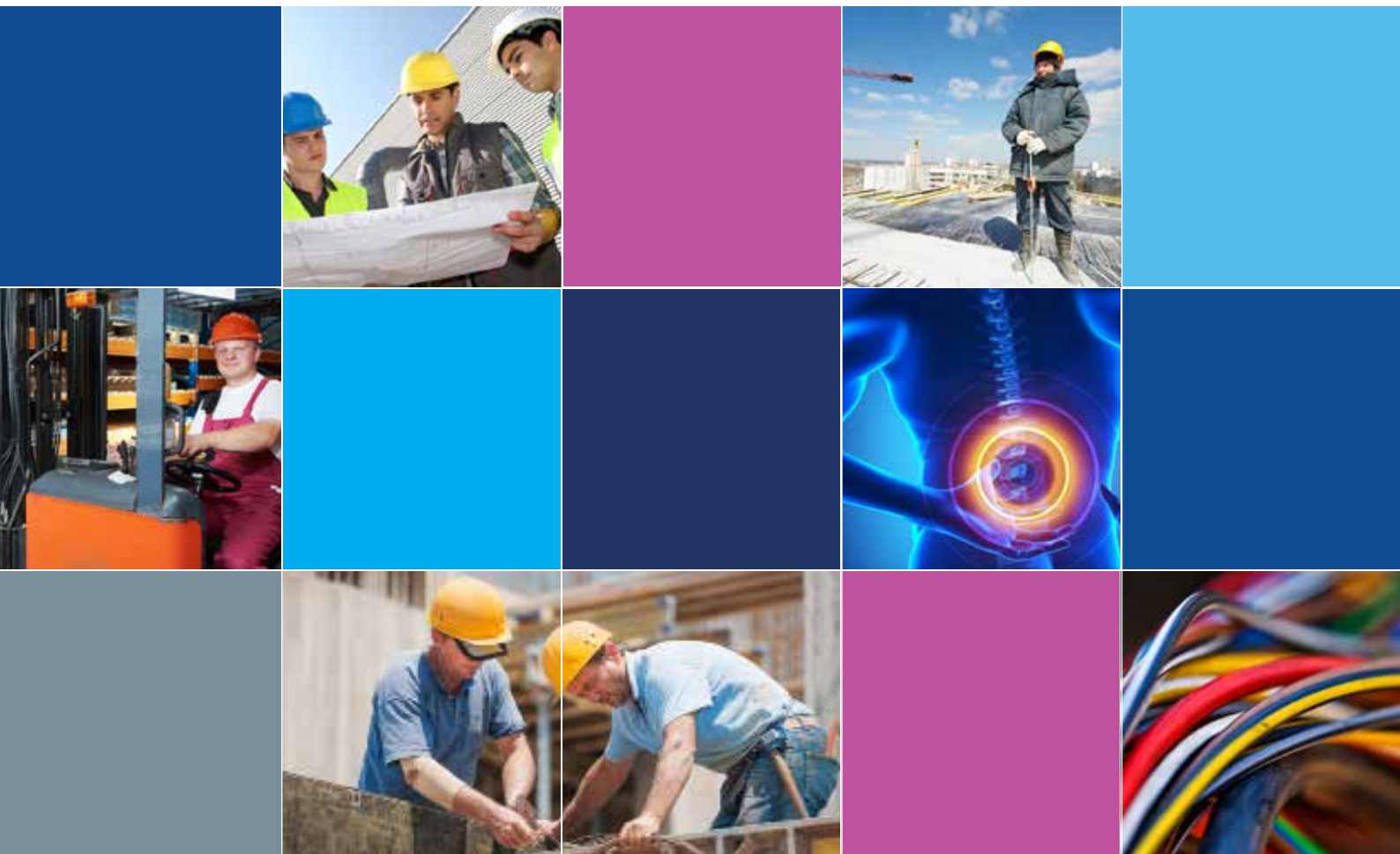

Classroom taught course

The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate covers the main legal requirements for construction health and safety in the UK, identification and control of construction workplace hazards, and the practical application of this knowledge. This is reflected in the three units that comprise the qualification. As well as covering a range of construction workplace hazards and methods of control, it includes the legal system in the UK and legislation relating to the management of health and safety at work.

Our classroom courses involve face-to-face teaching and provide an opportunity to discuss the topics with other students and the tutor and would suit those that enjoy interaction in a classroom environment. In particular, it has a number of features that may be helpful to those students who have not done formal study and examinations for some time.

Designed for: The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate is aimed at Supervisors, Managers and those with a role under the Construction Design and Management regulations 2015 within the construction industry who are required to ensure that activities under their control are undertaken safely.

Outline: A highly recommended entry level course to the National Diploma qualification. The National Certificate in Construction syllabus consists of two units: one focusing on risk management (NGC1) and the other on managing and controlling construction related hazards (NCC1). Assessment is two written examinations (one for each of the units NGC1 and NCC1) and a construction workplace-based practical assignment (NCC2).

Course content

The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate covers the main legal requirements for construction health and safety in the UK, identification and control of construction workplace hazards, and the practical application of this knowledge. This is reflected in the three units that comprise the qualification.

Assessment

The qualification is divided into three assessed units, each of which is assessed separately. Assessment is by two written examinations (one for each of the Units NGC1 and NCC1) and a work-based practical examination (Unit NCC2). All units must be completed within 5 years to achieve the full NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health and Safety.

Exams take place in March, June, September and December. Study programmes are designed to lead towards these dates. Examinations for in-house courses can be arranged with NEBOSH on demand, for a date to suit the learning programme.

Unit NGC1 is common to the NEBOSH Construction Certificate and the NEBOSH Fire Certificate.

When taking these awards students do not have to sit NGC1 again if they have passed it within the last five years.

Exam Tutorial/Revision Days

Tutorials are organised prior to each examination period and are an optional extra for all students. They provide an opportunity to revise and consolidate understanding.

The tutorials greatly assist those that need coaching in examination technique and will increase student confidence to complete the written and practical examinations, leading to higher success. Tutorials are open to students attending classroom based courses, e-learning and blended learning.



Other Methods of Learning

E-learning / distance learning
